WALKS

- 12 **Thomson River Flood Plain Walk** from Town to the Old Bridge. This four and a half kilometre one way track features a diverse range of plants and animals, best viewed in the early morning or late evening.
- 13 **Iningai Nature Reserve** There are three nature walks - one is the Coolibah Loop which is 3.7km long and is an easy 1 and a half hour walk.
- 14 **Linear Botanical Gardens Walk** This walk features a diverse range of plants, mostly native, which makes for a beautiful early morning or late evening walk.
- 15 **The Cemetery** Ask about the self-guided brochure produced by the Longreach Archival & Historical Group.
